In accordance with Team Guide (Issued by UNIF) to the main tournament was nominated 4 teams from Europe (with respect of Continental Club Cup in Corsica 2012) and 1 team from America and 1 from Asia. Other registered teams will compete in qualification.

**Group composition:**

Drawing lots for basic groups will be performed on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> of April with TVcom recording with assistance of Mr. Šiška, mayor of the city Modřice.

### **Rules:**

- official Laws of Futnet, no tie-break sets
- nomination to the game (discipline) is performed exactly before each respective game, separately. But only if the player is on the nomination list, which is approved by UNIF Technical Committee President, Mr.Vlastimil Stehlík. Nomination list for teams in qualification will be control on Thursday evening and for main tournament on Friday evening.

### **System:**

#### **1) Qualification**

- 1 groups for 4 teams, mutual matches for 2 winning sets
- 1 match consists of one double, one triple and one single game in this order
- each winning game (discipline) counts as a point
- order of criteria = discipline points, If two (2) or more participants win the same number of discipline points, the following criteria are in force:
  - a) More discipline points from the matches played between themselves
  - b) Higher difference of set points from the matches played between themselves
  - c) Higher difference of ball points from the matches between themselves
  - d) Same criteria b) and c) from all matches in the group
  - e) Drawing lots, if all previous criteria are the same
    - first teams in each group advance into main tournament, the others play ranking matches

#### **2) Main tournament**

- a) Basic groups - 2 groups for 4 teams, mutual matches for 2 winning sets
  - each winning game (discipline) counts as a point
  - order of criteria = the same as in qualification groups
  - first two teams from each group advance into semifinal matches
- b) Ranking matches – 2.Q-A v. 2.Q-B for the 9<sup>th</sup> place, 3.Q-A v. 3.Q-B for the 11<sup>th</sup> place
  - each discipline counts a point
  - in case of 2:0 the single is played only if both teams agree
- c) semifinal and final matches – 1A v. 2B, 2A v. 1B, winners play for the 1<sup>st</sup> place, no 3<sup>rd</sup> place match is played
  - each discipline counts a point
  - in case of 2:0 the single is played only if both teams agree
